### General Rules and Regulations for Dead Sled Garden Tractor Pulls

1. The pull will be held Monday night at 7:30 p.m.
  - Class 225 – 700 lbs.
  - Class 230 – 900 lbs.
  - Class 235 – 1,200 lbs.
2. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. If it exists, the participant or pit crew will be asked to leave the grounds. This includes language, gestures and the like.
3. All tractors must be stock including engine with a maximum horsepower of 20, and no more than two cylinders. Tractors will be weighed prior to the pull including the driver's weight. No tractor will be weighed without completed insurance release information sheet. All tractors must be a riding type with rubber tires and no chains. No dual wheeled or all four or all-wheel drive tractors are permitted. After weight-in weights may only be moved within the pulling area and in the presence of a judge. Hitch height will be 13 inches maximum.
4. No weight bar or boom to extend over 12 inches past the front of the tractor. No weight bar or parts to extend out over 6 inches to the side of the tractor. If anything falls from the tractor while on the pulling track, the tractor will be disqualified.
5. Anti-roll equipment to be in place if the front end is to come off the ground for the pull.
6. Puller must start with a tight hitch, no jerking of the sled.
7. Only one driver per class. A tractor can be pulled in more than one class with a different driver. Any minor must have written consent from a parent or guardian to pull. Participants in all classes must be able to operate the tractor safely. A judge will determine this.
8. Only class 235 is open to participants 18 and over.

9. Class 235 tractors must also be able to back into the sled under their own power.
10. Shifting gears, hydrostatic, automatic, variable, or gear type is permitted as long as forward motion of the sled does not stop.
11. Axles may be locked together if it helps to keep transaxle together.
12. A written protest can be submitted to the judges by a puller in the same weight class.
13. The judges will require a copy of the manufacturing specifications at this time.
14. Failure to present these specifications will disqualify contestant.
15. Engines may be changed provided they are stock replacement engines.
16. Winning tractors can be weighted and hitch height following the pull.
17. Tire size no larger than 26-12-12 unless written proof of manufacturer's specifications.
18. Judges decisions will be final in all situations.

- 20. \$5.00 entry fee for classes 225 & 230.**
