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General Regulations for Department 12 Hay and Grains

In the absence of completion, right is reserved to award a premium of grade, which the exhibited article merits.

Names will not be permitted on exhibits until after judging.

An exhibitor can enter only exhibit one in each class.

All exhibits must be grown within the Fair's surrounding community.

If the fair management believes any of the exhibits were shown in previous years, those entries may be refused.

11	12	C91	161	Grass - first cutting. Mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes.
11	12	C91	163	Grass – second cutting. Mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes.
11	12	C91	165	Mixed Hay – Any mixture not classified in the previous classes but which contains 50% or more singly or in combination of alfalfa, timothy clover and grasses.
