

General Rules for Goats

Judging:

1. All animals in a CLASS will be judged together.
2. An animal in a Class will NOT be able to win more than ONE PLACE
3. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged.
4. Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out to competing.
5. When on exhibition in the ring, each animal must be under halter and in charge of owner or owner's representative.
6. Open classes, 4-H and FFA project animals and Youth under 19 will be judged for premiums.
7. Open classes, 4-H and FFA members and Youth under 19 must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.

Superintendent:

1. The Senior Champion class shall consist of all first place winners in the first three classes or Doe one year old and under 2, and older animals.
2. The junior Champion class shall consist of all first place winners in classes 2 and 3 or Doe one year old and under 2 and younger animals.
3. Grand Champion Class shall consist of best of breed in each division.

4. Definitions:

- Get of Sire shall consist of three doe from a particular sire with not more than one under one year old allowed and not more than one animal from every multiple birth allowed.
- Get of Sire need not be owned by the exhibitors.
- Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Sire.
- Produce of Dam shall consist of two doe of different ages, the produce of one dam.

5. The exhibitor need not own produce of Dam.

6. Entries in this class shall be made in the name of the Dam.

7. Only Doe entered in other classes may compete in the Get of Sire and Produce of Dam classes.

The Exhibitor:

1. Is limited to show no more than 2 animals in each class of the eighteen Breeds listed.
2. will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the Superintendent may direct.
3. will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent; to accept the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance, and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may be to increase the educational value of the show.
4. Will not display decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at other shows until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges.

5. That has any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fair grounds.
6. Joint ownership considered being as one owner in accordance with registration papers.
7. will provide dividers to separate does and kids.

General

1. The same classifications and premium stated below are to apply to each of the following breeds:

ENTRY FORM:

1. 4-H & FFA must use the Department number 10.
2. Please print your club name
3. Please print your school name. Please print your age.
4. Youth 19 and Under use the Department number 11.
5. If you do not fit a. or b. above use Department number 01
6. The Section you print on the form comes from the section table. Print the letter and number (B41) on the Entry Form.
