

Market Swine

Generals Rules for Market Swine

Judging

1. Minimum weight 210 pounds, maximum weight 300 pounds; the weight of each animal will be announced.
2. Market class hogs can be barrows and or gilts
3. An exhibitor may show two (2) entries in one class.
4. No more than a total of (3) at the fair total.

Superintendent

1. Registration certificate (breeder signature) on purebred animals must be presented to the Superintendent. All other will be entered as cross.
2. State the number of pens need when making entries - minimum two (2) hogs to a pen.

The Exhibitor:

1. Exhibitors must have all animals listed for competition on the grounds no later than 1 pm thorough 5 pm on Sunday prior to the fairs start date to be weighed in.
2. All animals shall remain on the premises until 8 pm Saturday unless released by the Superintendent. All swine must be removed by 11 pm Saturday.
3. A class of less than (2) will be shown under other class and judge on same weight class.
4. Class weights will be determined after weigh in and be posted prior to show.
5. Any market swine showing signs of being a boar shall be eliminated from the show.

6. Ages as determined by January 1 of the current year.
7. All exhibitors must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.
8. All pens must be clean after the removal of animals.
