General Regulations for Log Saw & Chain Saw Contest

1. To participate in the chain saw contest. You must provide a valid driver's license or HOSTA certificate.
2. One Chain saw is to be used per individual. There will be **no sharing chain saws.**
3. Saws must be started and warmed up in the cutting area only.
4. Saws must be held pointed away from the spectator area at all times.
5. No competitors will be allowed to compete if under the influence of alcohol.
6. Hearing and eye protection must be worn at all times.
7. Cutting pants should be worn.
8. The official timekeeper will determine cutting time only.
9. In the event of a tie, the competitors will be required to cut a second time.
10. The time from the second cut will determine the finishing spot of those included in the tie.
11. Only one competitor per saw in each class
12. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THESE RULES COULD RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.**
