

Market Sheep

General Regulations for Market Sheep

Judging:

1. All animals in a CLASS will be judged together.
2. An animal in a Class will NOT be able to win more than ONE PLACE
3. Animals must be in the ring promptly at the time of call. Failure to comply may at the judge's discretion.

Superintendent:

1. When any class exceeds 15 entries the class may be divided and premiums paid for the added class at the discretion of the Superintendent.
2. Youth entering the purebred classes must have identified their animals as purebreds.
3. Minimum weight 65 pounds, maximum weight 145 pounds. Sheep weighing less than 60 pounds or more than 150 pounds will not be re-weighed.
4. The weight of each animal will be announced.
5. Class weights will be determined after weigh in and be posted prior to show.

The Exhibitor:

1. That has any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fair grounds.
2. Will have sheep individually identified by an ear tag.
3. Will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent

4. Is expected to accept the stall assigned with out controversy will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly as the Superintendent may direct.
5. Will not display decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at other shows until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges.
6. Must have Market sheep on the grounds no later than 1 pm through 5pm on Sunday prior to the fairs start date for weighted in.is expected to keep their animals in an attractive appearance
7. Is to cooperate with the Superintendent that will serve to increase the educational value of the show.
