General Rules and Regulations for Farm Tractor Pulls

1. Classes
 - Class 100 – 6,000lbs..... Tuesday 7:30 p.m.
 - Class 105 – 8,000lbs..... Thursday 7:30 p.m.
 - Class 110 – 12,000lbs..... Saturday 09:00 a.m.
 - Class 115 – Powder Puff Tractor Pull 6,000lbs... Saturday 09:00 a.m.
 - Class 125 – Antique Pre 1960 / 4,000 – 8,000lbs.... Saturday 09:00 a.m.
2. Contest open to farm owned tractors only, equipped with rubber tires, no four-wheel dual wheels or tire chains allowed, and no four wheels or all-wheel drive tractors allowed.
3. Only exception is the antique pulls where steel-wheeled tractors are encouraged.
4. Weight includes driver, no weight or driver changes after the weigh-in.
5. Only two attempts to weigh in.
6. No tractor will be weighed without completed insurance release information sheet.
7. Drawbar height will be a maximum of 18 inches. If a puller ring is to be used it must have 2 bolts and be secured parallel to draw bar.
8. No drawbar extensions will be allowed to gain an advantage.
9. No tractor will have a tread width that exceeds 8 feet.
10. All bolts shall not extend out in an unsafe manner.
11. Drawbars will be factory installed only.
12. Any items bolted to the drawbar that will be used to hook up to the tractor shall have case hardened bolts of no less than grade 8.
13. All weights must be of a factor manufacturer.
14. No weight shall interfere with the hook up to the sled.
15. A minimum of 18 inches square shall be open above and beside the drawbar, with no weights within that area.
16. All suitcase weights must be on a satisfactory bracket and be secured so that they are safe and do not rattle and flop around.
17. No suitcase weights can be attached to the wheels.
18. All round wheel weights shall be bolted into place and can only be used on the axle and wheels, unless they are secured on a bracket.
19. No loose or chained weights will be permitted.
20. Suitcase weights can be bracketed or will be permitted on the draw bar if there is a secure bracket to hold them on and the draw bar is not being used to the sled.
21. No weights can extend more than 12 inches past the trailing edge of the rear tires.
22. Any weight that by the discretion of the judge is unsafe or unsecured will be removed or the tractor will be permitted to compete.
23. Any weight that falls off the tractor will automatically disqualify that tractor from the contest.
24. All boxes on the tractor will be checked for loose weight.
25. Weight can be moved for balance or safety as long as there is a judge notified and it is moved in the judge's presence.
26. The fair scales will be the only recognized weighing device unless inoperable.
27. No altering of the governor.

Tractor Pulling (Continued)

28. No interference from drivers or spectators will be tolerated.
29. This is ground for cancellation of the pull.
30. The pull may be stopped or cancelled when unsafe conditions exist to further continue the show.

31. Judges have the right to stop any contestant's tractor when operated in an unsafe manner, in or out of the arena.
32. The judges' decision is final.
33. Winner to be determined by the total distance pulled.
34. Contestants will park their tractor within the arena upon weighing and pull a lottery number to determine the order of the pull.
35. The pull will promptly start at the scheduled time.
36. No alcoholic beverage permitted on the fair grounds and is grounds for disqualification from the pull.
37. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of alcohol will be barred from the pull.
38. Antique tractors pulling will be of stock class
39. Each hook is \$10.00.
