

Breeding Sheep

General Regulations for Sheep

Judging:

1. All animals in a CLASS will be judged together.
2. An animal in a Class will NOT be able to win more than ONE PLACE
3. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves as to when their stock will be judged.
4. Stock must be in the ring promptly on call and failure to comply with the order renders exhibitors liable to be ruled out to competing.
5. When on exhibition in the ring, each animal must be under halter and in charge of owner or owner's representative.
6. Open classes, 4-H and FFA project animals and Youth under 19 will be judged for premiums.
7. Open classes, 4-H and FFA members and Youth under 19 must be present and have charge of their animals at the time of judging.

Superintendent:

1. May call request current membership,
2. GRAND CHAMPION: Champion and Reserve Champion of each breed and the crossbreed division will compete for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Steer of the fair.
3. Definitions:
 - All classes will be held together and conducted on time.
 - A pen of Lambs consists of four lambs, both sexes represented.

- A Flock consists of one ram, any age; two ewes, one year and under two years; two ewes under one year.
 - Breeder's Young Flock consists of one ram lamb and two ewe lambs all bred and owned by exhibitor.
 - A Get of Sire shall consist of four breeding animals; any age or sex the get of one sire.
4. The exhibitor need not own Get.
 5. All show sheep must be individually identified by an ear tag.
 6. All lambs and sheep must be slick shorn within 10 days of show, unless breed states otherwise. This will be at the discretion of the Superintendent if it becomes a controversial matter.

The Exhibitor:

1. Is limited to show no more than 2 animals in each class of the eighteen Breeds listed.
2. will be expected to keep the space they occupy in a clean and sanitary condition and to remove all their equipment promptly will be expected to display or parade their animals as directed by the Superintendent; to accept the stall assigned without controversy; to keep their animals in an attractive appearance, and to cooperate with the Department in every way that may be to increase the educational value of the show.
3. Will not display decorations with ribbons or ornaments previously won by animals at other shows until after the awards have been made in their respective classes by the judges.
4. That has any animal of unthrifty nature, unsuitable condition, or which cannot be satisfactorily handled under show conditions must be removed from the fair grounds.

5. Joint ownership considered being as one owner in accordance with registration papers.
6. The same classifications and premium stated below are to apply to each of the following breeds:
7. Sheep exhibitors will furnish dividers to separate rams from ewes.

ENTRY FORM:

1. 4-H & FFA must use the Department number 10.
2. Please print your club name

5. Youth 19 and Under use the Department number 11.
